

Kuala Lumpur's Green Escape

DURATION: 4 HOURS

CAPACITY: GROUPS OF 30 PAX

(For group larger than 30 pax, staggered departures are possible up to a maximum of 200 pax)

The Forest Research Institute of Malaysia (FRIM) is a green haven just 40 minutes from Kuala Lumpur. Home to hundreds of plant species and animals, this secondary forest also boasts a 200m canopy walkway 30m above the ground that offers stunning forest views and an intimate encounter with nature. You will hear the high pitched sound made by an insect called cicada and if you observe your surroundings during your walk, you are likely to see birds, small mammals and reptiles. On a clear day, you will be able to see the Petronas Twin Towers from the canopy walkway.



Visit during the fruit season to see the fruit orchards in full bloom. A knowledgeable guide will be on hand to impart interesting facts on the flora and fauna found in the Malaysian jungle. Also on display here is a 70 year old Malaccan house and a 120 year old Terengganu house built with Chengal hardwood without the use of nails.

NOTE

Duration of jungle/nature walk can be modified to suit the physical level of your group. Canopy walk is close every Monday/Friday. Closing time of Canopy will be at 2:30pm on other days.
