You will sail past the city's historical landmarks such as the Astana built in 1870, Kuching State Mosque, The Old Court House, Square Tower, Main Bazaar, Chinese Museum, Fort Margherita and old Malay Villages. You will get unique insights and views of all aspects of traditional life by the river and the city.

The ship's interior has been completely renovated, establishing a new standard of luxury in river cruising. The double-decker mv Equatorial can accommodate up to 200 persons at any one time. The air-conditioned Mariner Lounge at the lower deck is suited for elegant dinner events whilst the skydeck on the upper deck is ideal for sunset cruises. It also has a sheltered sightseeing deck with an open-air performance stage.
